The Foundation is a completely separate charitable entity from the Spokane Valley Kiwanis Club although we share the same membership. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization which was established in 1996 and has contributed significantly to charitable causes since its inception.

Mission Statement: The purpose of the Spokane Valley Kiwanis Foundation is to support charitable organizations within the community, to assist in social and rehabilitative services for financially needy persons, and to fund specialized projects based on community needs.

Goals: The goals of the Spokane Valley Kiwanis Foundation are to fulfill our mission by identifying worthy capital projects, annually if possible, and providing funds to accomplish those projects solely or in partnership with others. Further, our aim is to grow the Foundation financially so that larger and perhaps more impactful projects may be undertaken. Toward that end we seek member and outsider donations on an annual basis. The remaining unspent dollars will be cautiously invested to aid the goal of growth.
